

Gift Aid Declaration

Why is Gift Aid so important to Ability2Access?

Gift Aid is a simple way to make your donation go even further. If your donation is eligible, Ability2Access can claim an extra 25% from HMRC.

This means that **for every £1 you give, it's worth £1.25** to Ability2Access, at **no extra cost to you**. These extra funds mean we can ensure there will be more money going to our cause.

In order to Gift Aid your donation, you must tick the box below.
